

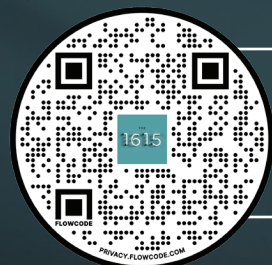

- 5 Exalt Jesus Christ through every aspect of the ministry!

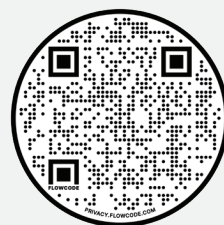
To God be the glory. Great things He has done and is doing.

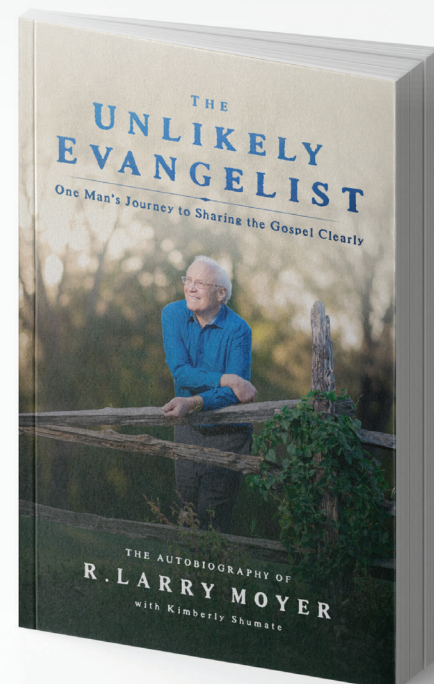

How to Create a *Legacy that Lasts*

We all want to live a life that matters, that impacts people for the Lord. Not only that, we want our lives to leave a legacy so that our impact blesses people for this life and throughout eternity.

The Apostle Paul provides a clear guide for creating this kind of legacy:

So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love.

1 Corinthians 13:13

Faith, hope, and love serve as three rare jewels arranged in the setting of our lives. Like precious stones, each of these virtues shares three key qualities. They are rare, eye-catching, and enduring. In today's culture, faith, hope, and love stand out because they are uncommon. Yet, their rarity makes them even more noticeable. Also, their enduring nature ("abide" means "to remain") ensures that their impact lasts both in this life and the next, leaving a legacy that cannot be erased.

Let's look at how each one contributes to a meaningful legacy.

FAITH

Faith is trust in God and His promises. It begins with salvation—trusting in Jesus alone to reconcile us with God. Faith continues as we follow Jesus, learning to trust Him in every aspect of life. As we live out our faith, we are also called to share our faith with others, leading them to place their trust in Christ alone. A life marked by faith leaves a legacy of spiritual transformation in others.

HOPE

Hope is our confident expectation regarding the future because of Christ. It empowers us to endure life's challenges, knowing God is working all things together for our good (Romans 8:28). Hope also fuels our anticipation of eternal life with God in heaven (1 Corinthians 13:12). This hope motivates us to reach and encourage others who are without hope, offering them a future full of God's fulfilled purposes and promises in their lives.

LOVE

Love, according to Paul, is the deliberate choice to seek another's highest good. Love is not simply a feeling, but a choice to put the welfare of others first. It is the greatest of the three virtues because it is the foundation of both faith and hope. Without God's love in Christ (John 3:16), we have no basis for faith and hope. Additionally, sharing our faith and hope with others is empty unless done with love. As the saying goes, "People don't care how much you know until they know how much you care."

When we live a life marked by *faith, hope, and love*, we leave a legacy that transforms lives and far outlasts our time on earth!
